Moreover, the trip offers delegates unprecedented networking opportunities with premier financial institutions in New York City.

Competition Rules

Selected stocks are to be focused on sustainable infrastructure companies with market capitalizations above US\$500 million and must be listed on the TSX, NYSE, or NASDAQ. **The four-slide pitch must include:**

- 1) Introduction
- 2) Investment Thesis
- 3) Catalysts & Risks
- 4) Valuation & Conclusion

Participants will be allowed a maximum of five appendix slides, in addition to a title page and the four-slide pitch. The seven finalists will be allowed to make minor edits to their stock pitch prior to the event.

Finalists will be judged and selected by a panel of QFAC alumni, assessing the submission's analytical rigour, aesthetic appeal, and the overall risk-reward attractiveness of the investment. Stock choices will be viewed as a long position with a 6 - 12 month time horizon.
