# POCKET PROJECTOR INSTRUCTIONS

#### Setting up the Projector

- 1. Plug the 2-pc Adapter into the Projector (port is labelled "DC") and into a power socket.
- 2. To use the Tripod, screw the Tripod into the screw hole at the bottom of the projector.

## Inputting a Video Source to the Projector

- 3. VGA: If your video source (i.e. computer) uses a VGA port, plug in the VGA Cable to the port on the side of the Projector (labelled "VGA") and into your video source.
- 4. **USB**: if your video source uses a USB port, plug in the USB Data Cable to the port on the back of the Projector (labelled "USB") and into your video source
- 5. **HDMI:** if your video source uses an HDMI port, plug in an HDMI cable (<u>NOT included in</u> <u>set</u>) to the port on the back of the Projector (labelled "HDMI") and into your video source.
- Other: if your video source does not have a VGA port, you'll need to use an adapter/converter that will convert your port into one of the aforementioned porta (e.g. Mac-VGA Adapter).

## Using the Projector

- 7. Hold down power button on the Projector until it hums and turns ON.
- 8. Remove the Projector's lens cover and direct the Projector toward a desired screen to display the projection.
- 9. Use the dial on the top of the Projector to adjust the display size of the projection.
- 10. To turn OFF, press the power button on the Projector twice.
