1. I will only be called on to serve if the CSP applicant is accepted to the program.
2. I am welcome to sign more than one of these agreements with CSP applicants, but understand that I would only be expected to serve as a mentor for one should more than one of applicants I have signed for be admitted into the program. At my discretion, I may elect to mentor more than one Scholar.
3. The research assistance work for the successful CSP applicant will start in the second semester of 2019-2020 or the summer between their third and fourth year (summer 2019).
4. The full costs of research assistantship (\$5000) for the successful applicant will be paid and administered by the Dean's Office.
5. I understand and accept the Mentor's responsibilities as follows:
  - To involve the Scholar as much as possible in parts of the Mentor's own research as a way to introduce him/her to the research process;
  - To help Scholar define his/her research project;
  - To actively supervise the research project conducted by the Scholar, including through regular meetings with the Scholar;
  - To assure that the RA work conducted by the Scholar that is supported by the program represents meaningful, educational contributions to the Mentor's research (and may possibly connect to the Scholar's research);
  - To attend presentations by the Scholar on his/her research proposal and on the finished product; and
  - To grade the Scholar's final paper.

- I also understand that, in the event a scholar is completing his/her degree in 5 years, he/she can request to substitute the year 4 residency requirement with one for year 5 upon approval of the CSP Steering committee.
