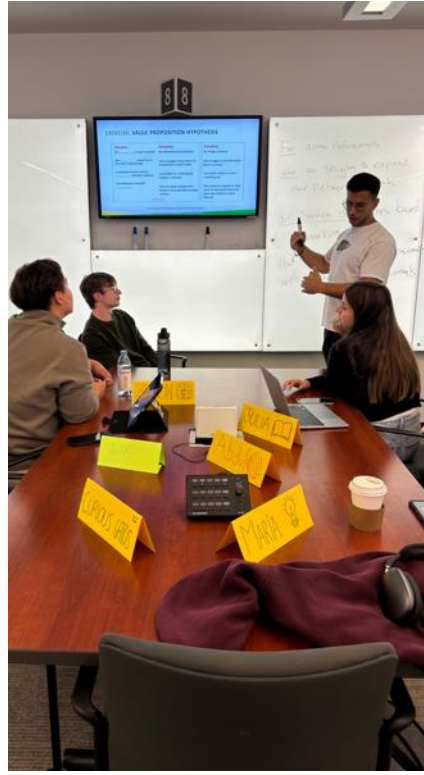
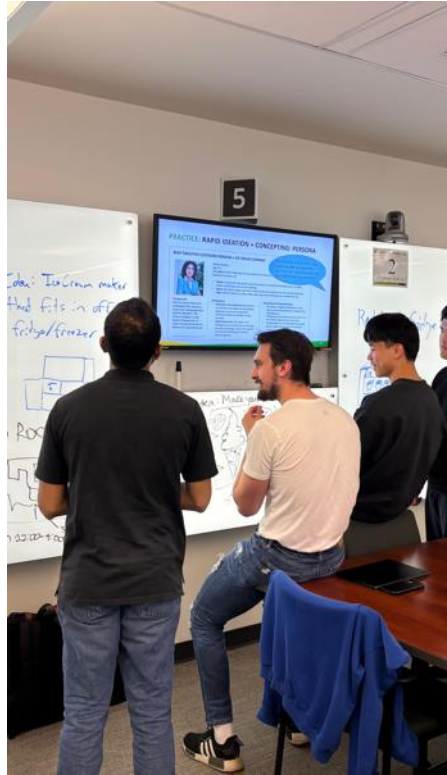
Entrepreneurs are not born -- they are made.

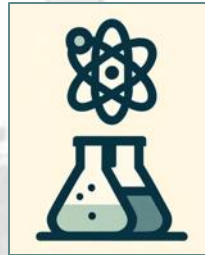
